

## IHP statement on Russia's invasion of Ukraine



*HET ВОЙНЕ : "N 2022* The IHP supervisory institutions both have made statements about the war in Ukraine - CNRS Sorbonne Université.

Dedicated to international exchange, the Institut Henri Poincaré expresses its deep concerns about the consequences of war and of restrictions of freedom in several countries.

These affect in particular established mathematicians but also the next generation, with promising mathematicians being killed, as was recently the Ukrainian <u>Yulia Zdanowska</u> in Kharkiv, or denied human rights, as is the Russian <u>Azat Miftakhov</u>.

The project MATEMATI/IKA by <u>Olga Paris-Romaskevich</u> was initiated during more peaceful times on the Eurasian continent. Awaiting the exhibition that should have taken place during the International Congress of Mathematicians, IHP encourages mathematicians from all over the world to visit the <u>project webpage</u>, and in particular to read this <u>statement</u>.

Furthermore, we also draw the attention of the mathematics community to the <u>webpage</u> set up by the <u>ERCOM committee</u> of the <u>European Mathematical Society</u>, gathering offers of assistance to mathematicians who are refugees of the recent war in Ukraine.
